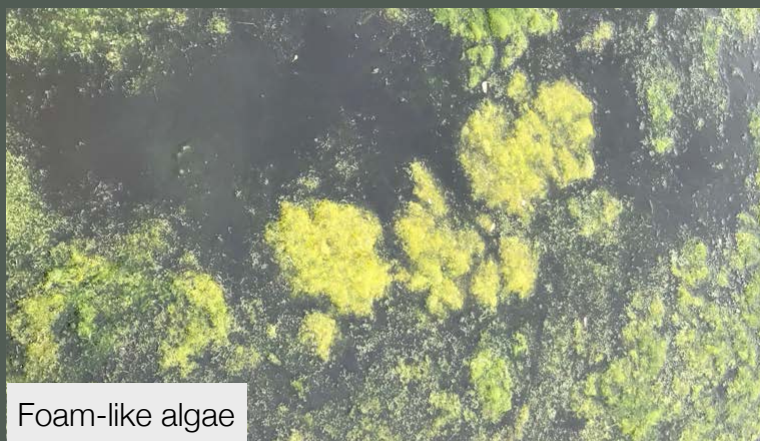


VISUAL GUIDE TO CYANOBACTERIA

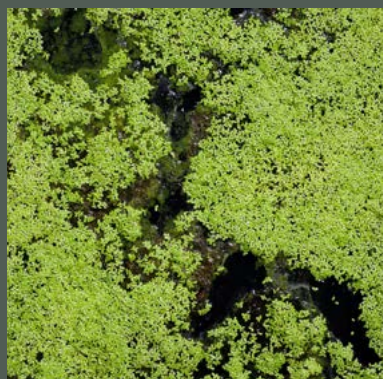

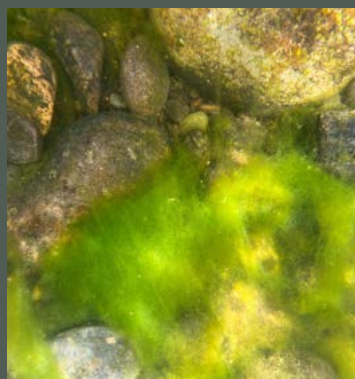
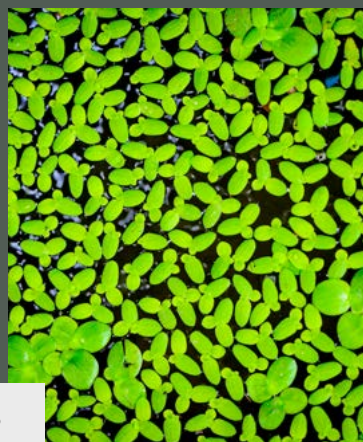
Foam-like algae

Floating leafy aquatic plants

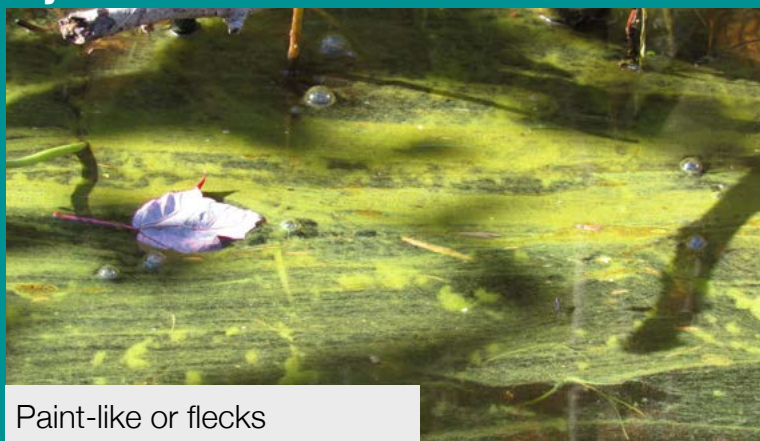


Filamentous or stringy green algae

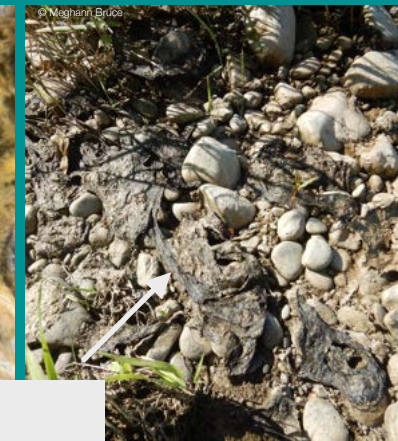
